3. (a) Read the following passage and based on Leech's (1983) perspective, state the illocutionary functions performed by the italicised utterances in the text for achieving social goals (8 marks)

Mr Okoronkwo walked into the room, angry to find some of his staff gathered around in a corner reading a newspaper with the screaming headline: *Nigeria Grabs Gold at Nation's Cup*. His fury knew no bounds when he also sighted Mr Obiyan, the supervisor, perched on Miss Lizzy's desk whispering in low tone. *You are welcome Sir*, everyone chorused as he walked briskly into his office, hardly paying attention to any of them. Lizzy, *come into my office immediately!* He bellowed as soon as he sat down on his seat. "Yes sir", Lizzy responded as she ran towards her boss' office in trepidation. *Do you know I can have you sacked for your irresponsibility lately*, Mr Okoronkwo screamed at her as soon she entered his office. The other staff listened in apprehension, not knowing what fate also awaited each of them.
