QUESTION 2

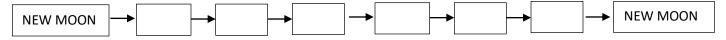
Besides the popular usage of the word "moon" in the narration of tales by moonlight, present a brief scientific fact about moon, citing two (2) points each on:
