- 08 Apr. 2010: Sold goods by cash N27,000 and by cheque N45,000.
- 10 Apr. 2010: Purchased goods N55,000 on credit from mercury stores.
- 11 Apr. 2010: Withdrew cash from the bank: N63,000 for office use and N7,000 for its owner.
- 13 Apr. 2010: Returned goods to Ace Products N2,500 and Mercury Stores N3,000.
- 15 Apr. 2010: Sold goods on credit to Go-getters Limited N46,500and Joy Venture N60,000.
- 16 Apr. 2010: Purchased Computers N90,000 by cheque.
- 18 Apr. 2010: Goods returned by Go-getters Limited N2,500 and Joy Ventures N4,000.
