1. (a) Define the following terms:

(i) condensing point (3 marks)

(ii) accumulation point of F, where F is a subset of E of the metric space (E, d).(3 marks)

- (a) Let (E, d_E) be a metric space and let (Y, d_Y) be a subspace of X. Let A be subset of Y. Show that A is closed in Y if and only if there exists a set F which is closed in E such that $A = Y \cap F$. (8 marks)
- (b) Verify that d is a metric on the real line: $(R, |\cdot|)$, where R denotes the set of real numbers and d: $R \times R \to R$ be defined by d(x, y) := |x y| for all $x, y \in R$.. (8 marks)
- 2. Show that every compact subset of a metric space is closed and bounded. (12 marks)
- 3. Show that a point x of a metric space (E, d) is a cluster point of a sequence $\{x_n\}$ in E if and only if there exists a subsequence $\{x_{n_k}\}$ of $\{x_n\}$ such that $x_{n_k} \to x$ as $k \to \infty$.

- 4. Prove that limits of a sequence are unique (i.e. if $\{x_n\}$ converges to both x and x^t then $x = x^t$). (12 marks)
- 5. Prove that $\{x_n\}$ converges to x in E, if and only if $\{d(x_n, x)\}$ converges to 0 in R. (12 marks)
- 6. Prove that every convergent sequence in any metric space is Cauchy. (12 marks)
