#### QUESTION ONE

(a) (i) If functions u, v, w of three independent variables x, y, z, define the Jacobian of the function If u = xyz,  $v = x^2 + y^2 + z^2$ , w = x + y + z, find  $J = \frac{\partial(u,v,w)}{\partial(x,y,z)}$ 

(ii) Given the functions  $u = x^2 + y^2$ , v = 2xy, determine the Jacobian. 10 Marks

(b) Determine the Wronskian of set  $\{e^x, e^{-x}\}$ .

4 Marks (c) If an entire function f(z) is bounded in absolute value for all z, then f(z) must be a constant. Thus prove the Liouville's theorem.

(d) Let f(z) be a function that is analytic inside a simple closed path C and on C, except for finitely many singular point  $z_1, z_2, ..., z_k$  inside C, then

$$\oint f(z) = 2\pi i \sum_{j=1}^k Res f(z).$$

Hence, prove the Residue theorem.

(a) Given  $f(x) = 9\cos 2x$  and  $g(x) = 2\cos^2 x - 2\sin^2 x$ , show that the function is linearly dependent. 3 Marks

(b) Compute the integrals  $\int_{-\pi/2}^{\pi/2} \int_{0}^{2\cos\theta} r^2 dr d\theta$ .

(c) Evaluate the integrals  $\int_0^1 \int_0^1 (x^2 + y^2) dx dy$ .

(a) If  $A = (3x^2 + 6y)i - 14yzj + 20xz^2k$ , evaluate  $\int_C A * dr$  from (0,0,0) to (1,1,1) along the following paths C. (i)  $x = t, y = t^2, z = t^3$ . 4 Marks

(b) (i) the straight lines from (0,0,0) to (1,0,0), then to (1,1,0), and the to (1,1,1)(ii) the straight line joining (0,0,0) and (1,1,1). 6 Marks

(c) Find the total work done in moving a particle in a force field given by F = 3xyi - 5zj + 10xk along the curve  $x = t^2 + 1$ ,  $y = 2t^2$ ,  $z = t^3$  from t = 1 to t = 2.5 Marks
